The works comprised of a new steel framed major extension to the existing surgery. The new building is set approximately 1.5m above the original surgery and joined with a link stairway and lift area. On completion of the extension the existing building was refurbished and the first floor offices remodelled. The building is a steel frame structure on concrete pads, with reinforced ground floor slab, and PCC plank first floor. External walls are an insulated Metsec system which was clad in brickwork to the ground floor and timber cladding to the 1st floor. The roof was a mix of single ply membrane to flat areas, and Zinc standing Seam to pitched areas. Windows and screens were powder coated aluminium. In addition to the building, an access road and car park were formed, and the area landscaped upon completion. The staff are reported to be overjoyed with their new facilities.
