Construction of a steel framed warehouse facility, clad in Kingspan trapezoidal cladding, specified to match neighbouring existing units, insulated with high reflective white finished metal internal linings. The building was designed to include clear internal spaces, which could be adopted by the customer for an indeterminate amount of needs. Floors were constructed from Grade C35 concrete on an appropriate sub base. The first floor containing office space, is supported on a pre-fabricated steel frame. The roof was clad in Kingspan trapezoidal cladding and rooflights installed to maximise natural light where available. Windows and doors are internally double glazed, with thermally broken aluminium sections.
