2020 Projects Updates

This year started off great with some fantastic projects won and started, and though March saw a nationwide lockdown we were up and running again by April and back to work, and what a busy year it's been completing, and starting new project!

Kings Fitness & Leisure

Alterations and Extension at Kings Fitness and Leisure

Contract Value: £677k Completed: November 2020

The project comprised of the construction of a new extension to create 2 new training studios, new offices, welfare areas and a new reception, along with the upgrade of the spin room studio and the therapy area. This project was completed in phases to enable the leisure centre to continue to remain open with minimal disruption to the buildings users and staff throughout the build.

This project was started before COVID-19 struck and had to stop due to the lockdown, but our fantastic site Manager Rick managed to complete the project as originally scheduled!





Refurbishment of Street Parish Rooms

Up-dating the Building for the Local Community

Contract Value: £178k Completed: November 2020



This was another great project undertaken with our friends at Orme Architects. This beautiful local historical building has undergone a full refurbishment inside including a full strip out and structural alterations to extend rooms, and to make room to install a much needed lift into the building. Electrics and plumbing have been updated and toilets and kitchen facilities have been replaced, new doors and screens have been added to the building, and window repairs have been undertaken where required. The building has had new flooring installed, and has been decorated throughout. A great project which means the building is ready for the community for many years to come!







Brookside Academy

Construction of WC block

Contract Value: £118k Completed: August 2020

This was another project for Brookside School completed in conjunction with Futures For Somerset. This project consisted of the removal of the existing temporary toilet block and constructing a new purpose built toilet block for the pupils of the school. The project involved the relocation of some trees and adapting the existing drainage system to enable the new facilities to be built, which has girls and boys toilets and full washing facilities. The new toilet area is now accessible to all with the new access ramp.

Avalon Plastic Ltd

New Side Extension

Contract Value: £366k

Completed: September 2020

This project was for a local firm, Avalon Plastics based in Glastonbury and only a stones throw from our office. We extended the factory due to the growth of the business, and had to complete the construction on this very tight and restricted site while the existing factory remained fully operational, and without interrupting the A39.

The new extension created a further 350 sqm of factory and storage facilities.

Contract Value: £555k

Completed: Phase 1 completed September

This project is being undertaken in 2 phases and works on phase 1 was completed and handed over to the client in early September with phase 2 still being completed. The work has been completed to enable the Medical Centre to maintain a level of service throughout. The project included the construction of 2 new extensions and refurbishment and upgrade of the existing building to create a new reception area, medical facilities and more consulting rooms to enable GPs to offer more services to their local community.
